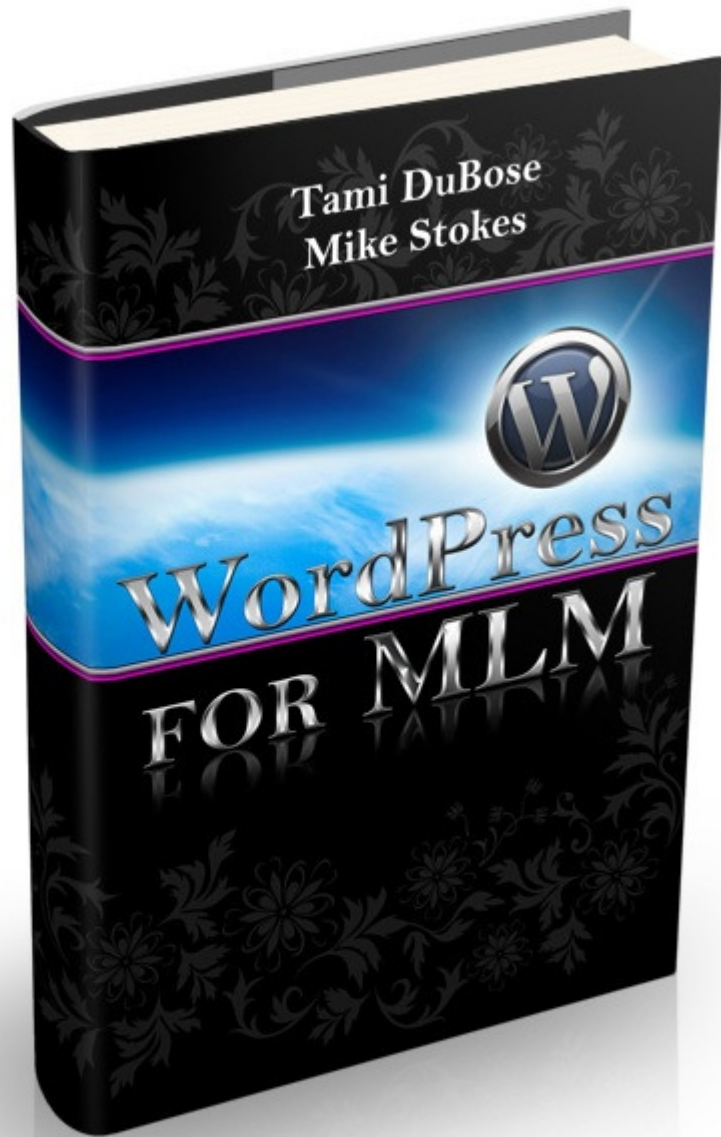

Step by step guidelines for setting up your hosting account:

1. [Click here to go to HostGator](#) (or go to <http://HostGatorDirect.com>)
2. Click the “**Web Hosting**” button near the top of the page, just below the [HostGator](#) logo.



3. Choose your plan on this page.

Note: You might see a button that reads “Windows Web Hosting”. IGNORE THIS BUTTON. This confuses people because they have a Windows operating system on their computer (unless they use a Mac). You want the “Linux Web Hosting” which is the default. In other words, you’re already on the Linux page.

When we direct you to **click** on something, it is obvious. . .


Permalink Settings

This one is also **VERY IMPORTANT**.



1. Click “**Permalinks**”
2. You want to check the bottom box that reads, “**Custom Structure**”



3. Type this in the box /%postname%/
4. Click “**Save Changes**”

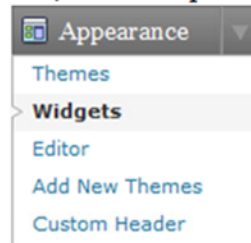
We may have given instructions on something in a previous chapter, but **we state it just as clearly when you have to do it later**, saving you the frustration of having to go back and look it up.

Step-by-step guidelines to Basic Widget Configuration

1. Log into your blog's admin panel at –

<http://yourdomainname.com/wp-admin>

2. Click “**Appearance**” in the left column, and a drop down box will open.



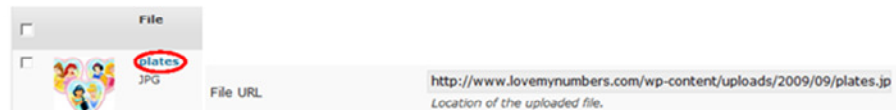
3. Click “**Widgets**”.

And, we have **fun**.

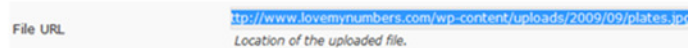
6. Click “**Library**” under Media and you'll see your picture listed to the right.



7. Click on your **file name**. You'll see the file details.



8. Copy the File URL, **the actual http string** in the grey box to the right of File URL.

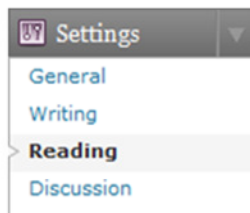
CHAPTER 13: How to Add a Home Page (or not)
